

TOWN OF PERU - DUMP ORDINANCE

Section 1. Public Dumps Established; Waste Matter not to be dumped elsewhere.

The Board of Selectmen shall designate certain places as dumping grounds for the dumping or depositing of any refuse, rubbish, or other waste material. The dumping of any such refuse, rubbish, or other waste material by any person at any other place than at such designated public dumping ground, except as hereinafter provided, shall be unlawful and a violation of the provision of this ordinance; provided, however, that the owner of any lot, or any other person with the permission of the owner, may dump or deposit upon such lot, earth, ashes, cinders, rocks, concrete, asphalt, or any other similar material for filling in purposes.

Section 2. Rules and Regulations

The Board of Selectmen shall have the authority to regulate the use and operation of such designated public dumping grounds and shall adopt such rules and regulations as are deemed necessary, specifying the days and times of the day when such public dumping grounds shall be open to the public for the depositing of refuse, rubbish, or other waste material. Said rules and regulations, when so adopted, shall be posted at the United States Post Offices in Peru Center, West Peru and East Peru and shall be published in the Rumford Falls Times at least seven (7) days before the effective date of said rules and regulations.

Said rules and regulations may be changed from time to time, as deemed necessary by said Board of Selectmen, and any such changes shall be posted at the United States Post Offices in Peru Center, West Peru and East Peru and shall be published in the Rumford Falls Times at least seven (7) days before the effective date of such changes.

Section 3. Depositing of Car Parts, etc. Prohibited

It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit parts of cars, automobiles, tires, etc. on such designated public dumping grounds.

Section 4. Penalty

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 plus costs which shall be recovered on complaint to the use of the Town of Peru.
